ENTRY FEE: \$35.00

Horses to be shown over a course of approximately 10 jumps not to exceed 3'0" in height with spreads to 3'0". Large ponies to jump 2'6" with spreads to 2'6", small/medium ponies to jump 2' with spreads to 2'. Classic will not be split unless there are 12 entries in each section. Full specifications and League Membership Forms available at the show office. USEF points for this classic. There must be 10 entries for the Classic to be held.

Prizemoney: \$75, \$50, \$40, \$35, \$30, \$20

NOTE: USHJA Rules require 6 entries for a classic to receive bonus points!

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entries can be made by mail, phone or Fax. Post entries will be accepted at no charge but pre-entries will be most appreciated.
2. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
3. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
4. The Worcester Stables Horse Show, Here & There Group, Worcester Stables, Inc., Briarwood Farms Inc., Katie Benson, the Horse Show Committee or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
5. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
6. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
7. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
8. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
9. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
10. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
11. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office.
12. All pets must be leashed.
13. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
14. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
15. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection per USEF Rules.
16. **ATTN EXHIBITORS:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheel-chairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
17. Should the veterinarian on call be needed to complete permanent measurement of horses or ponies, then the appointed time for said measurements will be 10:00 a.m. ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEASUREMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE THROUGH SHOW MANAGEMENT BY THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE THE SHOW. Phone (908)-534-8833 for information and procedures. Day measurements will of course be available at any time throughout the show .

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FROM NORTH WEST NJ: Take Rt. 202 South, turn right onto Rt. 73 West, turn left onto Berks road to end, turn left to the farm on the left
FROM PHILA.: Rt. 76 West to Plymouth Mtg., getting on Rt. 476 to Germantown Pike West. Stay on the Germantown Pike and once you pass THROUGH the intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to turn right onto Potshop Road, follow to end, turn left, make a quick right to the farm on the right
FROM KING OF PRUSSIA: Take 422 West to the Trooper/Audubon exit, follow to the Germantown Pike turn right, at next light turn left on Potshop Rd, follow to end, turn left and then a quick right to the farm on the right
FROM PA TNPK: Exit #333 for Norristown, follow signs for Plymouth R.d., left at light, go 300 yds to make right onto Germantown Pike West, follow to intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to make a right onto Potshop Rd., follow to end, make left and quick right to the farm on the right
